## DESCRIPTIVE WORDS

Face Shape: *Square, Oval, Round, Triangular, Heart-shaped,, Thin, Wide, Chiselled*

Skin and Complexion

Complexion is the natural appearance and colour of the skin, especially of the face. **Wrinkled, Freckled, Ruddy, Sallow, Tanned, pale, fair, spotless, silky, smooth, glowing, paper-thin or translucent etc**

Eyes

**TIP:** Pay attention to the eyes, as they often reveal much about a person.

- **Shape, size, and appearance:** *large, small, almond-shaped, round, crinkly, bulging, hooded, deep-set, close-set, hollow*
- **Eye colour:** *black, brown, hazel, green, blue, violet, gray, amber*
- **Eye expressions:** *piercing, mesmerizing, sad, sorrowful, haunted, gentle, sympathetic, warm, compassionate, expressive, bright, twinkling, lively, dancing, laughing, shifty, sly, distrusting, sleepy*

Mouth and Lips

- **Lip shape and size:** *thin, full, pouting, rosebud, pursed*
- **Mouth expressions:** *laugh, smile, beam, grin, frown, grimace, scowl, sneer, curl, pout*
- **Adjectives describing the mouth or mouth expressions:** *toothy, toothless, gap-toothed, kind, sweet, dimpled, relaxed, firm, serious, cruel*

Hair

- **Hair colour:** *black, brunette, brown, chestnut-brown, blond, honey-blond, golden-blond, ash-blond, fair, auburn, red, gray, silver, white, salt-and-pepper*
- **Hair styles:** *braids, ponytail, pigtails, bun, messy bun, twist, bob, ringlets, flip, extensions, bangs, buzz, layered, feathered, chopped, spiked, slicked down*
- **Little hair:** *thin, fine, limp, flat, balding, bald, bald spot, receding*

Facial Hair

- **Hair:** *beard, goatee, moustache, soul patch, sideburns*
- **Adjectives:** *bearded, bushy, stubbly, bristly, scratchy, unshaven, shaggy, whiskered, beardless, clean-shaven, smooth, trimmed, neatly-trimmed, pencil-thin*

Body

**TIP:** Choose strong verbs and adjectives.

- **Build:** *small, slim, slight, thin, lean, skinny, chunky, chubby, large, plump, round, pudgy, full-figured, ample, broad-shouldered, solid, muscular*
- **Posture:** *stand, sit, slouch, flop, lean, recline, rest, stretch, sprawl, curl up, roost, squirm, arch, slump, stoop, bend, hunch, scoot, walk, run, race, jog*
- **Adjectives (appearance):** *stylish, natty, smart, chic, classy, elegant, polished, draped, flowing, sheer, casual, relaxed, carefree, starched, crisp, sharp, dressy, lacy, shiny, shimmering, sparkling, glittery, sloppy, torn, ripped, tattered, dishevelled, slovenly, tacky, unkempt, faded, scratchy, worn, frayed, nubby, rough, smooth, pliable, warm, soft, quilted, knit*
