GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR CLASS K.G. (2020-2021)

Congratulations! Your child has been promoted to class K.G. He/she has been promoted in the new class as follows:

Nursery Blue to K.G. Giraffe

Nursery Green to K.G. Tiger

Nursery Orange to K.G. Kangaroo

Nursery Red to K.G. Elephant

Nursery Yellow to K.G. Zebra

Kindly note the following instructions:

- The new academic session 2020-21 will begin as per subsequent orders from the Directorate of Education. Information regarding the same will be shared with you via SMS/Whatsapp message from school.
- On the first day of school, your child will come to his/her previous class.
 1. To ease load, please send the books and note books (duly labelled) on the first day and skates on the second day.
 2. Labelling all of your child's belongings (school bag, water bottle, uniform, shoes) is very important to avoid mix-up.
 3. We will keep sending revision worksheets on Fridays as in class Nursery.
 4. Keep 3-4 copies of your child's passport size photographs in school uniform ready for almanac, ID card etc.

Curriculum Guidelines

Things you should know while your ward comes to class K.G:

- Formal Reading and Writing will start in class K.G.
- Revision of sounds done in class Nursery will help in reading complete words in class K.G.
- Vowels(a,e,i,o,u) will be introduced to read three letter

words such as e.g. cat, tub ,pin, dog, jet.....etc.

➤ वर्णतथा संबंधित शब्द जैसे:

ग- गमला, गाय.....

म- मछली, मटका.....

➤ Reading and writing of 2 or 3 letter words in Hindi e.g.

मग, कप, मटर, नमक..... will also be initiated.

➤ Revision of numbers from 1-10 by doing related activities such as –draw according to the number, cross out extra, draw more etc. will help in formation of mathematical and analytical reasoning.

➤ We shall continue doing practice of writing numbers, alphabets and हन्दिीवर्ण on slate in the prescribed manner.

➤ Involvement in cutting, printing, pasting and free hand drawing to enhance motor skills and creativity.

➤ Initially the children will work on the worksheets with the crayons only. Pencil, books and note books will be used later at a later stage.

The following guidelines are suggested for parents:

✓ Maintain a fixed routine for your child which should include reinforcement of academic activities and fun time such as physical activities, board games, music, dance etc.

We look forward to your active co-operation in the education and overall development of your child. Your feedback and suggestions are welcome.
