

Children enjoyed learning about the rainy season through songs, pictures, and fun crafts like paper boats and raindrop painting.




## Independence Day Celebration

## My Favourite Story Character




The students of Class II had Public Speaking Activity on the topic My Favourite Story Character. The students very confidently presented their topic with the props prepared during summer holidays.

**Recycled Paper Caps:** They made awesome caps using recycled paper and wrote "Environment Soldier" on them.


**Earth-Friendly Discussions:** Students talked about ways to protect the Earth and learned new ideas to help our planet.



Third Position- Nayan Malhotra and Ujjwal Aggarwal


## CBSE - Science Challenge-2025-26


